- 2. Why do we process your personal data?

At CASTILLA TERMAL S.L. we process the information provided by the interested parties in order to carry out a preliminary assessment of their state of health in order to detect possible problems and/or circumstances that require special attention before starting the health treatment.

No automated decisions will be made on the basis of the data provided

3. How long do we keep your data?

The data shall be kept for a maximum of five years.

4. What is our legal entitlement to process your data?

We indicate the legal basis for processing your data:

- Consent of the interested party. To conduct a preliminary assessment of your health status to detect
 possible problems and/or circumstances that require special attention before starting health
 treatment
- 5. What addressees receive your data?

Data will not be passed on to third parties, unless legally obliged to do so.

6. Transfer of data to third countries?

No transfers of data to third countries are foreseen.



7. What are your rights when you provide us with your data?

Any person has the right to obtain confirmation on whether in CASTILLA TERMAL S.L. we are processing or not personal data that concerns you.

Interested parties have the right to access their personal data, as well as to request rectification of inaccurate data or, if applicable, to request their deletion when, amongst other motives, such data are not longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected. You also have the right to the portability of your data.

Under certain circumstances, interested parties may request restriction on the processing of their data, in which case we will only keep them to file or defend ourselves against complaints.

Under certain circumstances and for reasons related to individual situations, interested parties may oppose the processing of their data. In this case, CASTILLA TERMAL S.L. will refrain from processing the data, except when there are overriding legitimate grounds, or the right to file or defend ourselves against possible complaints.

Where commercial communications are sent on the basis of the data controller's legitimate interest, the interested party may object to the processing of their data for that purpose.

If you have granted your consent for a specific purpose, you have the right to withdraw the granted consent at any time, without detriment to the legitimacy of the processing based on the consent prior to withdrawal.

If you feel that your rights have been violated in regard to the protection of your personal data, especially when you have not obtained satisfaction in the exercise of your rights, you can submit a claim before the competent Control Authority for Data Protection through its website: www.agpd.es.
